## Q3 Job Postings Insights



From July to September (Q3) of 2018, there were 86,700 unique jobs postings* from non-staffing agencies within the metro area of Hampton Roads. Of these, 24,130 ( $27.8 \%$ ) have been generated within the Administrative, Professional, Scientific \& Technical, and Finance and Insurance industries.

Note: Median posting duration for Administrative, Professional, Scientific \& Technical reflects the average duration of both industries.

[^0]:    *Unique Jobs Postings denotes the number of de-duplicated job advertisements listed by different companies on career sites and job boards. De-duplication is a process job postings must go through in order to best approximate demand for certain jobs. The reason this process is so important is because employers can list one job posting on many different career sites and job boards. By itself, this non-deduplicated postings number by itself is a dramatic overestimate of actual job demand.
